On the door: Geological Society Fellows and Candidate Fellows £30, Non-Fellows £40, Students £25.

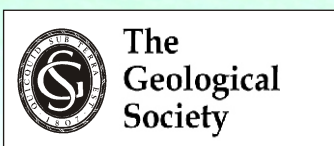
