The [Near Surface Geophysics Group \(NSGG\)](#) invites submissions from postgraduate students for our 2017 Postgraduate Research Symposium.

The NSGG is a special interest group of The Geological Society, with a remit of advancing, encouraging and supporting the study and practice of near-surface geophysics throughout the industrial and academic sectors. Our postgraduate symposia offer students of near-surface geophysics the opportunity to present their research to their peer group, plus a network of academic and industrial practitioners, in a relaxed and supportive environment.

We solicit abstracts from postgraduate students working in any aspect of near-surface geophysics, including environmental investigations, engineering, archaeology, forensic science, mineral exploration and geological mapping. To mark the Geological Society's "[Year of Risk](#)", we particularly encourage submissions from research into the application of geophysical methods in geohazards assessment: a special session of the meeting will be convened for presentations on this topic.

**The deadline for the submission of a 500-word abstract, plus 1 optional figure, is 17:00 on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> April 2017.** Abstracts should be emailed to Dr Adam Booth ([a.d.booth@leeds.ac.uk](mailto:a.d.booth@leeds.ac.uk)), with a stated preference for oral (15+5 mins) or poster presentation (*note: we cannot guarantee that all such preferences can be honoured*). All presenters will be considered for the NSGG Best Presentation Award. Lunch will provided at the event, generously sponsored by [RSK](#).

The fee for the Symposium includes co-registration for the NSGG Field Exhibition, also held at the Geophysics Test Site in Leicester, and we would encourage you to make the most of these opportunities. We look forward to seeing you in Leicester!
